

JAVA.UTIL.LINKEDHASHMAP.CLEAR METHOD

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Description

The **java.util.LinkedHashMap.clear** method removes all of the mappings from this map. The map will be empty after this call returns.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.util.LinkedHashMap.clear** method

```
public void clear()
```

Parameters

Return Value

This method does not return a value.

Exception

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.util.LinkedHashMap.clear method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class BitSetDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        // create a new linked hash map
        LinkedHashMap map = new LinkedHashMap(5);

        // add some values in the map
        map.put("One", 1);
        map.put("Two", 2);
        map.put("Three", 3);

        // print the map
        System.out.println("Map:" + map);

        // clear the map
        map.clear();

        // print the map
        System.out.println("Map:" + map);
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Map:{One=1, Two=2, Three=3}
Map: {}
```

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
