

JAVA.UTIL.LINKEDLIST.REMOVE METHOD

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Description

The **java.util.LinkedList.remove***int**index* method removes the element at the specified position in this list.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.util.LinkedList.remove** method

```
public E remove(int index)
```

Parameters

- **index** -- the index of the element to be removed

Return Value

This method returns the element previously at the specified position

Exception

- **IndexOutOfBoundsException** -- if the index is out of range

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.util.LinkedList.remove method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class LinkedListDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        // create a LinkedList
        LinkedList list = new LinkedList();

        // add some elements
        list.add("Hello");
        list.add(2);
        list.add("Chocolate");
        list.add("10");

        // print the list
        System.out.println("LinkedList:" + list);

        // remove the element at index 2
        System.out.println("Element to be removed:" + list.remove(2));

        // print the list
        System.out.println("LinkedList:" + list);
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
LinkedList:[Hello, 2, Chocolate, 10]
Element to be removed:Chocolate
LinkedList:[Hello, 2, 10]
```
