Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.util.LinkedList.size** method

```
public int size()
```

The following example shows the usage of java.util.LinkedList.size method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class LinkedListDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        // create a LinkedList
        LinkedList list = new LinkedList();

        // add some elements
        list.add("Hello");
        list.add(2);
        list.add("Chocolate");
        list.add("10");

        // print the list
        System.out.println("LinkedList:" + list);

        // print the size of the list
        System.out.println("List size:" + list.size());

        // add 2 more elements
        list.add("Coffee");
        list.add("Element");

        // print the size of the list
        System.out.println("List size:" + list.size());
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
LinkedList:[Hello, 2, Chocolate, 10]  
List size:4  
List size:6
```
