

# JAVA.UTIL.LOCALE.GETCOUNTRY METHOD

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## Description

The **java.util.Locale.getCountry** method returns the country/region code for this locale, which will either be the empty string or an uppercase ISO 3166 2-letter code.

## Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.util.Locale.getCountry** method

```
public String getCountry()
```

## Parameters

## Return Value

This method does not return a value.

## Exception

- NA

## Example

The following example shows the usage of java.util.Locale.getCountry method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class LocaleDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        // create a new locale
        Locale locale = new Locale("ENGLISH", "US");

        // print this locale
        System.out.println("Locale1:" + locale);

        // print the country of this locale
        System.out.println("Country:" + locale.getCountry());

    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Locale1:english_US
Country:US
```

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
