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Description

The **java.util.Locale.getDisplayCountry** method returns a name for the locale's country that is appropriate for display to the user.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.util.Locale.getDisplayCountry** method

```
public final String getDisplayCountry()
```

Parameters

Return Value

This method does not return a value.

Exception

- NA

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.util.Locale.getDisplayCountry method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class LocaleDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        // create a new locale
        Locale locale = new Locale("ENGLISH", "US");

        // print locale
        System.out.println("Locale:" + locale);

        // print locale display name
        System.out.println("Display Name:" + locale.getDisplayCountry());

    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Locale:english_US
Display Name:United States
```

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
