

JAVA.UTIL.SCANNER.IOEXCEPTION METHOD

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Description

The **java.util.Scanner.ioException** method returns the IOException last thrown by this Scanner's underlying Readable. This method returns null if no such exception exists.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.util.Scanner.ioException** method

```
public IOException ioException()
```

Return Value

This method returns the last exception thrown by this scanner's readable

Exception

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.util.Scanner.ioException method.

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class ScannerDemo {

    public static void main(String[] args) {

        String s = "Hello World! 3 + 3.0 = 6 ";

        // create a new scanner with the specified String Object
        Scanner scanner = new Scanner(s);

        // print the line
        System.out.println("'" + scanner.nextLine());

        // check if there is an IO exception
        System.out.println("'" + scanner.ioException());

        // close the scanner
        scanner.close();
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result:

```
Hello World! 3 + 3.0 = 6
null
```

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
