

JAVA.UTIL.SIMPLETIMEZONE.GETDSTSAVINGS METHOD

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Description

The **getDSTSavings** method is used to return the amount of time in milliseconds that the clock is advanced during daylight saving time.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.util.SimpleTimeZone.getDSTSavings** method.

```
public int getDSTSavings()
```

Parameters

The method call returns the number of milliseconds the time is advanced with respect to standard time.

The following example shows the usage of **java.util.SimpleTimeZone.getDSTSavings**

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class SimpleTimeZoneDemo {
    public static void main( String args[] ){
        // create simple time zone object
        SimpleTimeZone stobj = new SimpleTimeZone(720, "US");

        // check DST saving
        int dstsaving=stobj.getDSTSavings();
        System.out.println("DST saving : " + dstsaving);
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result.

```
DST saving : 0
```

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
