

# JAVA.UTIL.SIMPLETIMEZONE.GETRAWOFFSET METHOD

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## Description

The **getRawOffset** method is used to get the GMT offset for this time zone.

## Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.util.SimpleTimeZone.getRawOffset** method.

```
public int getRawOffset()
```

The method call returns the GMT offset value in milliseconds.

The following example shows the usage of `java.util.SimpleTimeZone.getRawOffset`

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class SimpleTimeZoneDemo {
    public static void main( String args[] ){
        // create simple time zone object
        SimpleTimeZone stobj = new SimpleTimeZone(720,"INDIA");

        // get raw offset
        int offset=stobj.getRawOffset();

        // check raw offset value
        System.out.println("Raw Offset is : " + offset);
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result.

```
Raw Offset is : 720
```

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
