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Description

The **hashCode** method is used to generate the hash code for the SimpleDateFormat object.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.util.SimpleTimeZone.hashCode** method.

```
public int hashCode()
```

Parameters

The method call returns the hash code for this object.

The following example shows the usage of java.util.SimpleTimeZone.hashCode

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class SimpleTimeZoneDemo {
    public static void main( String args[] ){
        // create simple time zone object
        SimpleTimeZone stobj = new SimpleTimeZone(820,"US");

        // get hash code
        int hashCode=stobj.hashCode();

        // check hash code value
        System.out.println("Hash code is : " + hashCode);
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result.

```
Hash code is : 820
```

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
