Description

The **hasSameRules***TimeZoneother* method is used to 'true' if this zone has the same rules and offset as another zone.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.util.SimpleTimeZone.hasSameRules** method.

```
public boolean hasSameRules(TimeZone other)
```

Parameters

- **other**--This is the TimeZone object to be compared with

Return Value

The method call returns 'true' if the given zone is a SimpleTimeZone and has the same rules and offset as this one.

The following example shows the usage of java.util.SimpleTimeZone.hasSameRules

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class SimpleTimeZoneDemo {
    public static void main( String args[] ){
        // create two simple time zone object
        SimpleTimeZone stobj1 = new SimpleTimeZone(820, "US");
        SimpleTimeZone stobj2 = new SimpleTimeZone(820, "GMT");

        // check rules for both objects
        boolean samerule=stobj1.hasSameRules(stobj2);

        // checking the value
        System.out.println("Hash same rule : " + samerule);
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result.

```
Hash same rule : true
```
