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Description

The **toString** method is used to get a string representation of this time zone.

Declaration

```
public String toString()
```

The following example shows the usage of java.util.SimpleTimeZone.toString

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class SimpleTimeZoneDemo {
    public static void main( String args[] ){
        // create simple time zone object
        SimpleTimeZone stobj = new SimpleTimeZone(820,"US");

        // get string value of time zone
        System.out.println("String value is : " + stobj.toString());
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result.

```
String value is : java.util.SimpleTimeZone[id=US,offset=820,dstSavings=36000000,
useDaylight=false,startYear=0,startMode=0,startMonth=0,startDay=0,
startDayOfWeek=0,startTime=0,startTimeMode=0,endMode=0,endMonth=0,
endDay=0,endDayOfWeek=0,endTime=0,endTimeMode=0]
```

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
