

JAVA.UTIL.TIMEZONE.GETDSTSAVINGS METHOD

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Description

The **getDST Savings** method is used to return the amount of time to be added to local standard time to get local wall clock time.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.util.TimeZone.getDST Savings** method.

```
public int getDST Savings()
```

Parameters

Return Value

The method call returns the amount of saving time in milliseconds.

Exception

Example

The following example shows the usage of `java.util.TimeZone.getDST Savings`

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class TimeZoneDemo {
    public static void main( String args[] ){

        // create time zone object
        TimeZone timezone = TimeZone.getTimeZone("Europe/Paris");

        // checking DST saving
        System.out.println("DST saving is :" + timezone.getDST Savings());
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result.

```
DST saving is :3600000
```

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
