Following is the declaration for **java.util.TimeZone.getID** method.

```
public String getID()
```

The method call returns the ID of this time zone.

The following example shows the usage of java.util.TimeZone.getID

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class TimeZoneDemo {
    public static void main( String args[] ){

        // create time zone object
        TimeZone timezone = TimeZone.getTimeZone("Europe/Paris");

        // checking ID of this time zone
        System.out.println("ID value is :" + timezone.getID());
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result.

```
ID value is :Europe/Paris
```

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
