

JAVA.UTIL.TIMEZONE.INDAYLIGHTTIME METHOD

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Description

The **inDaylightTime** method is used to query if the given date is in daylight savings time in this time zone.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.util.TimeZone.inDaylightTime** method.

```
public abstract boolean inDaylightTime(Date date)
```

Parameters

- **date** -- This is the given Date

Return Value

The method call returns true if the given date is in daylight savings time, false, otherwise.

Exception

- NA

Example

The following example shows the usage of java.util.TimeZone.inDaylightTime

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class TimeZoneDemo {
    public static void main( String args[] ){

        // create time zone object
        TimeZone timezoneone = TimeZone.getDefault();

        // create date object
        Date date = new Date(2008 , 05, 28);

        // checking day light
        System.out.println("In daylight time:" +timezoneone.inDaylightTime(date));
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result.

```
In daylight time:false
```

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
