

JAVA.UTIL.TIMEZONE.SETRAWOFFSET METHOD

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Description

The **setRawOffset** method is used to set the base time zone offset to GMT. This is the offset to add to UTC to get local time.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.util.TimeZone.setRawOffset** method.

```
public abstract void setRawOffset(int offsetMillis)
```

Parameters

- **offsetMillis** -- This is the given base time zone offset to GMT.

Return Value

- NA

Example

The following example shows the usage of `java.util.TimeZone.setRawOffset`

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class TimeZoneDemo {
    public static void main( String args[] ){

        // create time zone object
        TimeZone tzone = TimeZone.getDefault();

        // set raw offset
        tzone.setRawOffset(10000);

        // checking offset value
        System.out.println("Offset value is :"+tzone.getRawOffset());
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result.

```
Offset value is :10000
```

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
