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Description

The **useDaylightTime** method is used to query if this time zone uses daylight savings time.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.util.TimeZone.useDaylightTime** method.

```
public abstract boolean useDaylightTime()
```

Parameters

Return Value

The method call returns true if this time zone uses daylight savings time, false, otherwise.

Exception

Example

The following example shows the usage of `java.util.TimeZone.useDaylightTime`

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class TimeZoneDemo {
    public static void main( String args[] ){

        // create time zone object
        TimeZone tzzone = TimeZone.getDefault();

        // checking daylight time
        System.out.println("Using day light time :"+tzzone.useDaylightTime());
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result.

```
Using day light time :false
```

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
