Description

The **version** method is used to return the version number associated with this UUID. The version number describes how this UUID was generated.

Declaration

Following is the declaration for **java.util.UUID.version** method.

```
public int version()
```

The following example shows the usage of java.util.UUID.version

```
package com.tutorialspoint;

import java.util.*;

public class UUIDDemo {
    public static void main(String[] args) {
        // creating UUID
        UUID uid = UUID.fromString("38400000-8cf0-11bd-b23e-10b96e4ef00d");

        // checking version value
        System.out.println("Version value: "+uid.version());
    }
}
```

Let us compile and run the above program, this will produce the following result.

```
Version value: 1
```
