

JAVA EXAMPLES - USE OF CONTINUE

Problem Description:

How to use continue in a method?

Solution:

This example uses continue statement to jump out of a loop in a method.

```
public class Main {  
    public static void main(String[] args) {  
        StringBuffer searchstr = new StringBuffer(  
            "hello how are you. ");  
        int length = searchstr.length();  
        int count = 0;  
        for (int i = 0; i < length; i++) {  
            if (searchstr.charAt(i) != 'h')  
                continue;  
            count++;  
            searchstr.setCharAt(i, 'h');  
        }  
        System.out.println("Found " + count  
            + " h's in the string.");  
        System.out.println(searchstr);  
    }  
}
```

Result:

The above code sample will produce the following result.

```
Found 2 h's in the string.  
hello how are you.
```
