

JAVASCRIPT - ARRAY PUSH METHOD

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Description

JavaScript array **push** method appends the given elements in the last of the array and returns the length of the new array.

Syntax

Its syntax is as follows –

```
array.push(element1, ..., elementN);
```

Parameter Details

element1, ..., elementN: The elements to add to the end of the array.

Return Value

Returns the length of the new array.

Example

Try the following example.

```

  <title>JavaScript Array push Method</title>
</head>

  <script type="text/javascript">
    var numbers = new Array(1, 4, 9);

    var length = numbers.push(10);
    document.write("new numbers is : " + numbers );

    length = numbers.push(20);
    document.write("<br />new numbers is : " + numbers );
  </script>

</body>
</html>
```

Output

```
new numbers is : 1,4,9,10
new numbers is : 1 4 9 10 20
```

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
