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Description

Javascript boolean **toSource** method returns a string representing the source code of the object.

Note – This method is not compatible with all the browsers.

Syntax

Its syntax is as follows –

```
boolean.toSource()
```

Return Value

Returns a string representing the source code of the object.

Example

Try the following example.

```

<head>
  <title>JavaScript toSource() Method</title>
</head>

<body>

  <script type="text/javascript">
    function book(title, publisher, price)
    {
      this.title = title;
      this.publisher = publisher;
      this.price = price;
    }

    var newBook = new book("Perl", "Leo Inc", 200);
    document.write(newBook.toSource());
  </script>

</body>
</html>
```

Output

```
{title:"Perl" publisher:"Leo Inc" price:200})
