## Description

Javascript boolean **valueOf** method returns the primitive value of the specified **boolean** object.

## Syntax

Its syntax is as follows –

```
boolean.valueOf()
```

## Return Value

Returns the primitive value of the specified **boolean** object.

## Example

Try the following example.

```

  <head>
    <title>JavaScript valueOf() Method</title>
  </head>

  <body>

    <script type="text/javascript">
      var flag = new Boolean(false);
      document.write( "flag.valueOf is : " + flag.valueOf() );
    </script>

  </body>
</html>
```

## Output

```
flag.valueOf is : false
```
