

JAVASCRIPT - DATE GETSECONDS METHOD

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Description

JavaScript date **getSeconds** method returns the seconds in the specified date according to local time. The value returned by **getSeconds** is an integer between 0 and 59.

Syntax

Its syntax is as follows –

```
Date.getSeconds()
```

Return Value

Returns the seconds in the specified date according to local time.

Example

Try the following example.

```

  <head>
    <title>JavaScript getSeconds Method</title>
  </head>

  <body>

    <script type="text/javascript">
      var dt = new Date( "December 25, 1995 23:15:20" );
      document.write("getSeconds() : " + dt.getSeconds() );
    </script>

  </body>
</html>
```

Output

```
getSeconds() : 20
```

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
