Its syntax is as follows –

```
Math.abs( x ) ;
```

Example

Try the following example program.

    <script type="text/javascript">
      var value = Math.abs(-1);
      document.write("First Test Value : " + value );

      var value = Math.abs(null);
      document.write("<br />Second Test Value : " + value );

      var value = Math.abs(20);
      document.write("<br />Third Test Value : " + value );

      var value = Math.abs("string");
      document.write("<br />Fourth Test Value : " + value );
    </script>

  </body>
</html>
```

Output

```
First Test Value : 1
Second Test Value : 0
Third Test Value : 20
Fourth Test Value : NaN
```
