

# JAVASCRIPT - MATH FLOOR METHOD

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## Description

This method returns the largest integer less than or equal to a number.

## Syntax

Its syntax is as follows –

```
Math.floor( x ) ;
```

## Parameter Details

**x** – A numbers.

## Return Value

Returns the largest integer less than or equal to a number x.

## Example

Try the following example program.

```

  <script type="text/javascript">
    var value = Math.floor(10.3);
    document.write("First Test Value : " + value );

    var value = Math.floor(30.9);
    document.write("<br />Second Test Value : " + value );

    var value = Math.floor(-2.9);
    document.write("<br />Third Test Value : " + value );

    var value = Math.floor(-2.2);
    document.write("<br />Fourth Test Value : " + value );
  </script>

</body>
</html>
```

## Output

```
First Test Value : 10
Second Test Value : 30
Third Test Value : -3
Fourth Test Value : -3
```
