

JAVASCRIPT - MATH MAX METHOD

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Description

This method returns the largest of zero or more numbers. If no arguments are given, the results is **-Infinity**.

Syntax

Its syntax is as follows –

```
Math.max(value1, value2, ... valueN ) ;
```

Parameter Details

value1, value2, ... valueN : Numbers.

Return Value

Returns the largest of zero or more numbers.

Example

Try the following example program.

  <title>JavaScript Math max() Method</title>

  <script type="text/javascript">
    var value = Math.max(10, 20, -1, 100);
    document.write("First Test Value : " + value );

    var value = Math.max(-1, -3, -40);
    document.write("<br />Second Test Value : " + value );

    var value = Math.max(0, -1);
    document.write("<br />Third Test Value : " + value );

    var value = Math.max(100);
    document.write("<br />Fourth Test Value : " + value );
  </script>

</body>
</html>
```

Output

```
First Test Value : 100
Second Test Value : -1
Third Test Value : 0
Fourth Test Value : 100
```
