

JAVASCRIPT NUMBER - MIN_VALUE

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Description

The **Number.MIN_VALUE** property belongs to the static **Number** object. It represents constants for the smallest possible positive numbers that JavaScript can work with.

This constant has actual value 5×10^{-324}

Syntax

The syntax to use MIN_VALUE is –

```
var val = Number.MIN_VALUE;
```

Example

Try the following example.

```

    <script type="text/javascript">
      <!--
        function showValue()
        {
          var val = Number.MIN_VALUE;
          alert("Value of Number.MIN_VALUE : " + val );
        }
      //-->
    </script>
