Syntax

Its syntax is as follows –

```
number.toLocaleString()
```

Try the following example.

    <title>JavaScript toLocaleString() Method </title>
  </head>

  <body>

    <script type="text/javascript">
      var num = new Number(177.1234);
      document.write( num.toLocaleString());
    </script>

  </body>
</html>
```

Output

```
177.1234
```
