

JAVASCRIPT NUMBER - TOSTRING

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Description

This method returns a string representing the specified object. The **toString** method parses its first argument, and attempts to return a string representation in the specified radix *base*.

Syntax

Its syntax is as follows –

```
number.toString( [radix] )
```

Parameter Details

radix – An integer between 2 and 36 specifying the base to use for representing numeric values.

Return Value

Returns a string representing the specified Number object.

Example

Try the following example.

```

  <head>
    <title>JavaScript toString() Method </title>
  </head>

  <body>

    <script type="text/javascript">
      num = new Number(15);
      document.write("num.toString() is " + num.toString());
      document.write("<br />");

      document.write("num.toString(2) is " + num.toString(2));
      document.write("<br />");

      document.write("num.toString(4) is " + num.toString(4));
      document.write("<br />");
    </script>

  </body>
</html>
```

Output

```
num.toString() is 15
num.toString(2) is 1111
num.toString(4) is 33
```

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
