

# JAVASCRIPT - REGEXP GLOBAL PROPERTY

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## Description

**global** is a read-only boolean property of RegExp objects. It specifies whether a particular regular expression performs global matching, i.e., whether it was created with the "g" attribute.

## Syntax

Its syntax is as follows –

```
RegExpObject.global
```

## Return Value

Returns "TRUE" if the "g" modifier is set, "FALSE" otherwise.

## Example

Try the following example program.

```

  <title>JavaScript RegExp global Property</title>
</head>

<body>

  <script type="text/javascript">
    var re = new RegExp( "string" );

    if ( re.global ){
      document.write("Test1 - Global property is set");
    }
    else
    {
      document.write("Test1 - Global property is not set");
    }
    re = new RegExp( "string", "g" );

    if ( re.global ){
      document.write("<br />Test2 - Global property is set");
    }
    else
    {
      document.write("<br />Test2 - Global property is not set");
    }
  </script>
</body>
</html>
```

## Output

```
Test1 - Global property is not set
Test2 - Global property is set
```
