

JAVASCRIPT - REGEXP MULTILINE PROPERTY

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Description

multiline is a read-only boolean property of RegExp objects. It specifies whether a particular regular expression performs multiline matching, i.e., whether it was created with the "m" attribute.

Syntax

Its syntax is as follows –

```
RegExpObject.multiline
```

Return Value

Returns "TRUE" if the "m" modifier is set, "FALSE" otherwise.

Example

Try the following example program.

```

  <title>JavaScript RegExp multiline Property</title>
</head>

<body>

  <script type="text/javascript">
    var re = new RegExp( "string" );

    if ( re.multiline ){
      document.write("Test1-multiline property is set");
    }
    else
    {
      document.write("Test1-multiline property is not set");
    }
    re = new RegExp( "string", "m" );

    if ( re.multiline ){
      document.write("<br/>Test2-multiline property is set");
    }
    else
    {
      document.write("<br/>Test2-multiline property is not set");
    }
  </script>

</body>
</html>
```

Output

```
Test1 - multiline property is not set
Test2 - multiline property is set
```
