

JAVASCRIPT STRING - SUBSTRING METHOD

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Description

This method returns a subset of a String object.

Syntax

The syntax to use substr is as follows –

```
string.substring(indexA, [indexB])
```

Argument Details

- **indexA** – An integer between 0 and one less than the length of the string.
- **indexB** – *optional* An integer between 0 and the length of the string.

Return Value

The substring method returns the new sub-string based on given parameters.

Example

Try the following example.

```

  <head>
    <title>JavaScript String substring() Method</title>
  </head>

  <body>

    <script type="text/javascript">
      var str = "Apples are round, and apples are juicy.";

      document.write("(1,2): " + str.substring(1,2));
      document.write("<br />(0,10): " + str.substring(0, 10));
      document.write("<br />(5): " + str.substring(5));
    </script>

  </body>
</html>
```

Output

```
(1,2): p
(0,10): Apples are
(5): , s are round, and apples are juicy.
```

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
