Description

This method is used to convert the characters within a string to lowercase while respecting the current locale. For most languages, it returns the same output as **toLowerCase**.

Syntax

Its syntax is as follows –

```
string.toLocaleLowerCase( )
```

Return Value

Returns a string in lowercase with the current locale.

Example

Try the following example.

```
<html>
  <head>
    <title>JavaScript String toLocaleLowerCase() Method</title>
  </head>

  <body>

    <script type="text/javascript">
      var str = "Apples are round, and Apples are Juicy.";
      document.write(str.toLocaleLowerCase( ));
    </script>

  </body>
</html>
```

Output

```
apples are round and apples are juicy.
