

JQUERY - TOGGLEFN, FN2, FN3, ... METHOD

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Description:

The **togglefn, fn2, fn3, ...** method toggles among two or more function calls every other click.

Whenever a matched element is clicked, the first specified function is fired, when clicked again, the second is fired, and so on.

Syntax:

Here is the simple syntax to use this method:

```
selector.toggle( fn, fn2, fn3, ... )
```

Parameters:

Here is the description of all the parameters used by this method:

- **fn, fn2, fn3.....:** The functions to be executed against clicks.

Example:

Following is a simple example a simple showing the usage of this method:
