

JSTL FN:SPLIT FUNCTION

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The fn:split function splits a string into an array of substrings based on a delimiter string.

Syntax:

The fn:split function has following syntax:

```
java.lang.String[] split(java.lang.String, java.lang.String)
```

Example:

Following is the example to explain the functionality of this function:

```
<%@ taglib uri="http://java.sun.com/jsp/jstl/core" prefix="c" %>
<%@ taglib uri="http://java.sun.com/jsp/jstl/functions" prefix="fn" %>

<title>Using JSTL Functions</title>
</head>
<body>

<c:set var="string1" value="This is first String."/>
<c:set var="string2" value="${fn:split(string1, ' ')}" />
<c:set var="string3" value="${fn:join(string2, '- ')}" />

<p>String (3) : ${string3}</p>

<c:set var="string4" value="${fn:split(string3, '- ')}" />
<c:set var="string5" value="${fn:join(string4, ' ')}" />

<p>String (5) : ${string5}</p>

</body>
</html>
```

This would produce following result:

```
String (3) : This-is-first-String.
String (5) : This is first String
```

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
