Description

This function interprets EXPR as a hexadecimal string and returns the value, or converts \$_ if EXPR is omitted.

Syntax

Following is the simple syntax for this function –

```
hex EXPR  
  
hex
```

Return Value

This function returns numeric value equivalent to hexa in scalar context.

Example

Following is the example code showing its basic usage –

```
#!/usr/bin/perl  
  
print hex '0xAf'; # prints '175'  
print "\n";  
print hex 'aF';   # same
```

When above code is executed, it produces the following result –

```
175  
175
```
