

PERL IMPORT FUNCTION

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Description

This function is an ordinary method *subroutine* defined *orinherited* by modules that wish to export names to another module. The use function calls the import method for the package used.

Syntax

Following is the simple syntax for this function –

```
import LIST
```

Return Value

This function does not return any value.

Example

Following is the example code showing its basic usage –

```
#!/usr/bin/perl

package Util;
use base 'Exporter';

our @EXPORT_OK = ('foo', 'bar');

sub foo {
    print "foo!";
}
sub bar {
    print "bar!";
}

package Amy;
use Util 'foo'; # only import foo()
foo();          # works fine
bar();          # blows up
```

When above code is executed, it produces the following result –

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
