

PERL INT FUNCTION

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Description

This function returns the integer element of `EXPR`, or `$_` if omitted. The `int` function does not do rounding. If you need to round a value up to an integer, you should use `sprintf`.

Syntax

Following is the simple syntax for this function –

```
int EXPR  
  
int
```

Return Value

This function returns the integer part of `EXPR`.

Example

Following is the example code showing its basic usage –

```
#!/usr/bin/perl  
  
$int_val = int( 6.23930 );  
print"Integer value is $int_val\n";  
  
$int_val = int( -6.23930 );  
print"Integer value is $int_val\n";  
  
$int_val = int( 10 / 3 );  
print"Integer value is $int_val\n";
```

When above code is executed, it produces the following result –

```
Integer value is 6  
Integer value is -6  
Integer value is 3
```
