```
lcfirst EXPR  
lcfirstc
```

Return Value

This function returns the string EXPR or \$_ with the first character lowercased.

Example

Following is the example code showing its basic usage –

```
#!/usr/bin/perl  
  
$orig_string = "This is Test and CAPITAL";  
$changed_string = lcfirst( $orig_string );  
  
print "Changes String is : $changed_string\n";
```

When above code is executed, it produces the following result –

```
Changes String is : this is Test and CAPITAL
```
