

PERL ORD FUNCTION

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Description

This function returns the ASCII numeric value of the character specified by `EXPR`, or `$_` if omitted. For example, `ord('A')` returns a value of 65.

Syntax

Following is the simple syntax for this function –

```
ord EXPR  
ord
```

Return Value

This function returns Integer.

Example

Following is the example code showing its basic usage –

```
#!/usr/bin/perl -w  
print("ord() ", ord('G'), "\n");
```

When above code is executed, it produces the following result –

```
ord() 71
```
