

PERL SIN FUNCTION

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Description

This function returns the sine of `EXPR`, or `$_` if not specified. This function always returns a floating point.

Syntax

Following is the simple syntax for this function –

```
sin EXPR  
  
sin
```

Return Value

This function returns the Floating Point sin value of `EXPR`

Example

Following is the example code showing its basic usage –

```
#!/usr/bin/perl  
  
$temp = sin(4);  
  
print "sin value of 4 is $temp";
```

When above code is executed, it produces the following result –

```
sin value of 4 is -0.756802495307928
```
