Description

This function truncates *reduces* the size of the file specified by FILEHANDLE to the specified LENGTH *inbytes*. Produces a fatal error if the function is not implemented on your system.

Syntax

Following is the simple syntax for this function –

```
truncate FILEHANDLE, LENGTH
```

Return Value

This function returns undef if the operation failed and 1 on success.

Example

Following is the example code showing its basic usage, it will truncate file "test.txt" to zero length –

When above code is executed, it produces the following result –
