

# PERL UC FUNCTION

## Description

This function returns an uppercased version of `EXPR`, or `$_` if not specified. Check `ucfirst()` function which will return only first character in uppercase.

## Syntax

Following is the simple syntax for this function –

```
uc EXPR
```

```
UC
```

## Return Value

This function returns String in uppercase.

## Example

Following is the example code showing its basic usage –

```
#!/usr/bin/perl -w

$string = 'the cat sat on the mat.';
$u_string = uc($string);

print "First String |$string|\n";
print "Second String |$u_string|\n";
```

When above code is executed, it produces the following result –

```
First String |the cat sat on the mat.|
Second String |THE CAT SAT ON THE MAT.|
```
