

PERL UCFIRST FUNCTION

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Description

This function returns the value of `EXPR` with only the first character uppercased. If `EXPR` is omitted, then uses `$_`.

Syntax

Following is the simple syntax for this function –

```
ucfirst EXPR  
  
ucfirst
```

Return Value

This function returns String with first character in uppercase.

Example

Following is the example code showing its basic usage –

```
#!/usr/bin/perl -w  
  
$string = 'the cat sat on the mat.';  
$u_string = ucfirst($string);  
  
print "First String |$string|\n";  
print "Second String |$u_string|\n";
```

When above code is executed, it produces the following result –

```
First String |the cat sat on the mat.|  
Second String |The cat sat on the mat.|
```
