Description

This function is identical to the `tr///` operator; translates all characters in `SEARCHLIST` into the corresponding characters in `REPLACEMENTLIST`. It does character by character conversion

Syntax

Following is the simple syntax for this function –

```
y/SEARCHLIST/REPLACEMENTLIST/
```

Return Value

This function returns the number of characters modified.

Example

Following is the example code showing its basic usage –

```
#!/usr/bin/perl -w

$string = 'the cat sat on the mat.';

# This will generate a upper case string
$string =~ y/a-z/A-Z/;

print "$string\n";
```

When above code is executed, it produces the following result –

```
THE CAT SAT ON THE MAT.
```
