




Given below are the steps to add a shape in PowerPoint.

Step 1: Go to Illustrations group under Insert Tab




Step 2: Click on the **Shapes** drop down to view available shapes

Step 4: Click and drag on the slide to create the shape. As you drag the shape will show up on the slide. Continue to drag and adjust the size and symmetry of the shape.
