

RUBY/TK - COMBOBOX WIDGET

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Description:

A **Combobox** combines an entry with a list of choices available to the user. This lets them either choose from a set of values you've provided *e. g. , typicalsettings*, but also put in their own value.

Syntax:

Here is a simple syntax to create this widget:

```
Tk::BWidget::ComboBox.new(root){  
    ....Options....  
}
```

Options:

Combobox combines the options related to *TkEntry* and *TkListbox* widgets.

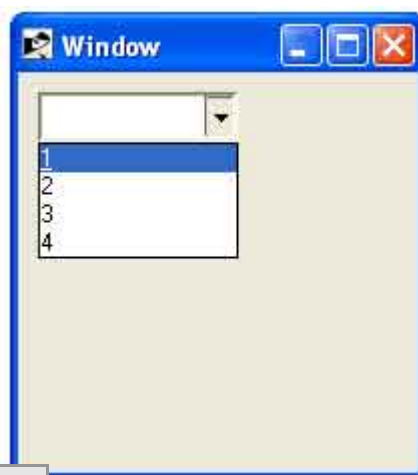
Event Bindings:

Combobox inherits event bindings from *TkEntry* and *TkListbox* widgets.

Examples:

```
require 'tk'  
require 'tkextlib/bwidget'  
  
root = TkRoot.new  
root.title = "Window"  
  
combobox = Tk::BWidget::ComboBox.new(root)  
combobox.values = [1, 2, 3, 4]  
combobox.place('height' => 25,  
               'width'  => 100,  
               'x'      => 10,  
               'y'      => 10)  
  
Tk.mainloop
```

This will produce the following result:



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
