

DRAG & DROP WITH CONSTRAINT OPTION

Description

This option is used to limit the draggable directions, either *horizontal* or *vertical*. Defaults to null which means free movement.

Syntax

Here is the simple syntax to use the *constraint* option.

```
new Draggable('element', {constraint:null, "horizontal" or "vertical"});
```

Example

      window.onload = function() {
        new Draggable('myimage', {constraint:"horizontal"});
      }
    </script>
