

DRAG & DROP WITH REVERT OPTION

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Description

If set to true, the element returns to its original position when the drag ends. It also specifies whether the *revertEffect* callback will be invoked when the drag operation stops. Defaults to false.

Syntax

Here is the simple syntax to set the *revert* option.

```
new Draggable('element', {revert:true});
```

Example

    <title>Draggables Elements</title>

    <script type="text/javascript" src="/javascript/prototype.js"></script>
    <script type="text/javascript" src="/javascript/scriptaculous.js"></script>

    <script type="text/javascript">
      window.onload = function() {
        new Draggable('myimage', {revert:true} );
      }
    </script>
  </head>
  <body>
    <p>Drag it and then leave it to see the result:</p>
    <img />
  </body>
</html>
```

This will produce following result –
