

SCRIPT.ACULO.US - SLIDEUP EFFECT

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Description

This effect simulates a window blind, where the contents of the affected elements scroll up.

Syntax

You can use one of the following two forms to use this effect –

```
new Effect.SlideUp('id_of_element', [options]);  
  
OR  
  
new Effect.SlideUp(element, [options]);
```

Effect-Specific Parameters

This effect does not have any other parameter except the [common parameters](#).

Example

      function SUEffect(element){  
        new Effect.SlideUp(element, {duration:3});  
      }  
  
      function ShowImage(element){  
        new Effect.Appear(element,{duration:1, from:1, to:1.0});  
      }  
    </script>  
  
  </head>  
  <body>  
  
    <div onclick="ShowImage('myimage')">  
      Click me to display the image  
    </div>  
    <br />  
  
    <div >  
        
      <h2>Click me to Slide Up the Image</h2>  
    </div>

</html>
