

# VBSCRIPT IF ELSE STATEMENTS


An **If** statement consists of a boolean expression followed by one or more statements. If the condition is said to be True, the statements under **If** conditions are Executed. If the Condition is said to be False, the statements under **Else** Part would be executed.

## Syntax

The syntax of an if statement in VBScript is:

```
If(boolean_expression) Then
    Statement 1
    .....
    .....
    Statement n
Else
    Statement 1
    .....
    .....
    Statement n
End If
```

## Example

```
<!DOCTYPE html>
<html>
<body>
<script language="vbscript" type="text/vbscript">
Dim a : a = 5
Dim b : b = 25

If a > b Then
    Document.write "a is Greater"
Else
    Document.write "b is Greater"
End If

</script>
</body>
```

</html>
```

When the above code is executed, it produces the following result:

b is Greater
